The statewide organization began in the 1960s when a group of Mississippi contractors met and proposed the idea of an association to represent the state's commercial construction industry, seeking a new way to discuss concerns, differences, and improvements in the industry. As the group, then called the Mississippi General Contractors Association, grew stronger, it joined Associated Builders and Contractors. At the time, ABC represented less than 5,000 companies across the country. Today, ABC has more than 22,000 members in 68 chapters across the country.

Over the past 50 years, leadership of ABC Mississippi has included top construction professionals and state executives, representing the construction industry in legislative matters, business development, and networking. These professionals have given their time and resources for the betterment of the construction industry.



In Smith's 2023 chairman message to the association, he wrote, "Many of the past chairmen have been influential in my own career over the past 40 years, and I'm thankful for the opportunity I've had to learn from them."
